Inside us there is a light that the scriptures say is brighter than a thousand suns. It lies in the heart so it is felt and experienced directly and is not a mental creation. Therefore it cannot be changed by the mind although the mind can ignore it. This is similar to the ocean of air we breathe – we pay no attention to it, but it remains what it is – the support of all life.

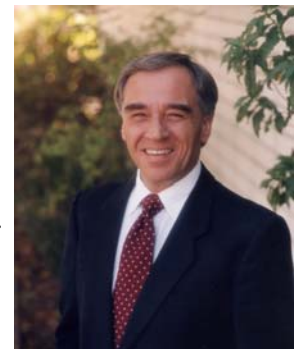
This inner sun is the cause of our existence. It is life itself. It feels like bliss that is independent of the world. As the physical sun illuminates the planets, this inner light illuminates the mind. Nothing is hidden from it. So there is no need to be devious; all our thoughts, good or bad are seen by this one light. We are like dogs hiding under the bed – our tails stick out and we can always be found!

In Religious Science we talk a great deal about the conscious and subconscious mind. But these terms are defined relative to one another. The subconscious mind is only called this because the conscious mind is unaware of parts of it. And the conscious mind is only spoken of this way because it identifies with personality and body which the subconscious does not.

The inner light shines in the subconscious and we say that we have discovered some trait or emotion that we did not know was inside us. This brings about *purification*. It shines in the conscious mind and we say that we feel more awake and alert, ‘My lights are turned on.’ This brings about *self-realization*.

The art of life is learning to live as though this light is our source and only support. This means that our relationship to this light is the only factor in our well-being in this outer world and in our internal mental/emotional world. This means having faith that we are *now* whole. Trusting the still, radiant presence to supply whatever we need is our goal.

Slowly our identity changes from being a person with an inner light to being the light. This is called *enlightenment*. At this point we have become the presence that transcends both conscious and subconscious. We simply are. The drama of existence goes on but we simply witness it.

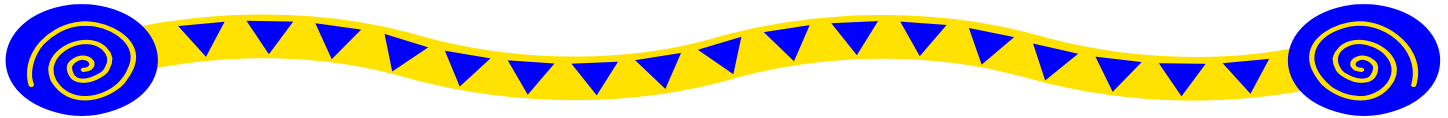
The traits of the mind are seen but we do not identify with them. Pain is felt but we do not own it. New ideas are born and we see them and engage them – or not. It is a glorious play.

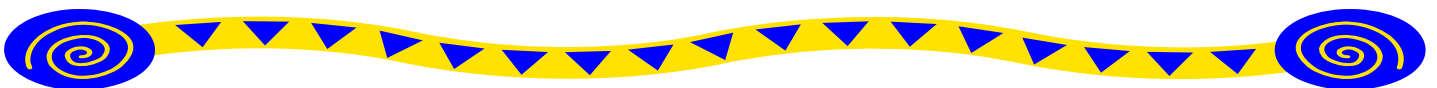

Practitioner's Corner

It's spring! Spring is the time for renewal in every sense of the word. As Mother Nature reawakens in the cycle of life and adorns our planet in the beauty and splendor of new beginnings, let us also look inside for our own awakening to the beauty and glory of our own inherent nature. The most efficient use of resources we have available to do this is to clean out old ideas and renew our thinking. It becomes necessary to clean out the closets and cobwebs of one's own mind and revisit how we think about this thing we call life.

Even while knowing the value of cleaning out old stale thinking to make way for the renewal of springtime, it is so easy to live in a perpetual winter, isn't it? We believe what we want to believe whether or not it is true. It is a tendency of the human mind, or the ego mind as distinguished from One Mind, to believe in old paradigms, to accept that which we have been taught is true over the glory and magnificence of infinite possibility and potentiality. The person who can consciously assent to the power of the inner voice becomes a realized individuation of the whole. We discover that voice by freeing oneself from the influence of home and parents or other predominant attitudes. We must part company with the crowded interior of our mind.

The egoic mind will replay old fears and constrictions and believe those thoughts are real. I am reminded of the traveler who thought he saw a snake in the path. He was found dead the next morning lying next to a length of rope having succumbed to a fear induced heart attack. Until we develop the ability to identify false ideas and assumptions and question our personal beliefs we suffer the consequences of our incorrect thinking. How do we examine and clear out those beliefs that cause us suf-

fering?

Inquiry into thought patterns is a form of dharma, the process of bonding with truth and discarding outdated belief systems, or any identification with group-think. Dharma is how God seeks Self as the individuated holy Whole. Through meditation and the quieting of the mind we begin to listen to our own instructions. We release old, confused and painful experiences of seasons past. Through inquiry, moment by moment in each new now we begin to experience our glory and magnificence, bringing a renewed and refreshed resurrected Self into this now moment without the worn out baggage of the past. A new self is born out of the old. It is time for the joy and celebration of spring renewal. We surrender to the present moment and rejoice.

The founder of Religious Science, Ernest Holmes, tells us that sooner or later there comes a time when we must surrender our weakness to its strength, our lack to its abundance and our fear to its faith. What is this process of surrender? outdated thoughts and false ideas, perception of lack and fear cause suffering in your life?

Isn't this surrender of which Dr. Holmes speaks of, the fourth aspect of affirmative prayer, what we in Religious Science call treatment?

We are asked to release our thought into that which is greater than the self and trust in the ever-givingness of Life itself. It may be uncomfortable at first but this abandonment of conventional beliefs while simultaneously trusting in the intelligence of Life is the only experience that can shatter the stronghold of the ego. We use dharma to question one’s own belief system, discarding untruth and ignorance, springing into the awareness of new growth. This process is the evolution of consciousness becoming aware of its own true nature.

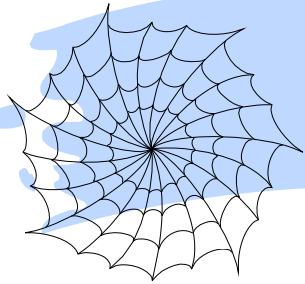
